	<h2>Description</h2> <p>This method allows printing <b>&lt;TAG&gt;</b> formatted text with line breaks. They can be automatic (as soon as the text reaches the right border of the cell) or explicit (via the <code>\n</code> character). As many cells as necessary are output, one below the other.</p> <p>Text can be <b>aligned</b>, <b>centered</b> or <b>justified</b>. Different <b>Font</b>, <b>Sizes</b>, <b>Styles</b>, <b>Colors</b> can be used. The cell block can be framed and the background painted. The behavior/paramaters of the method are the same as to the <a href="#">FPDF Multicell</a> method. <a href="#">Links</a> can be used in any tag.</p> <p><b>TAB</b> spaces (<code>(t)</code>) can be used. The <code>ttags</code> tag name is reserved for the TAB SPACES.</p> <p>Variable Y relative positions can be used for <code>Subscript</code> or <code>Superscript</code>.</p> <p><b>Controlled Tab Space</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tab Space 1</li> <li>- Tab Space 2</li> <li>- Tab Space 2</li> <li>- Tab Space 3</li> <li>- Tab Space 1</li> <li>- Tab Space 2</li> </ul> <p>If no <b>&lt;TAG&gt;</b> is specified then the FPDF current settings are used.</p>
